# FOREWORD

The purpose of the Northwest Common-Name Check List of Plants is to help

1. Improve communications about ecosystems between scientists who are trained in scientific plant nomenclature and the great preponderance of other scientists and practitioners, such as range conservationists, foresters, wildlife biologists, teachers, farmers, ranchers, youth groups and recreationists, who relate to plants primarily through the use of common names.
2. Provide a basis for uniformity in common plant names such as exists for birds and other animals in the Northwest.
3. Perpetuate that unique historical feature of the old-time art of rangeland and forest management that is represented by the common names used by residents and practitioners to identify plants locally and regionally.

## Scientific Names

The scientific-name base for the Northwest Check List is *Northwest Plant Names and Symbols for Ecosystem Inventory and Analysis, 4th Edition*. U.S.D.A. Forest Service General Technical Report PNW-46. 1976.

All synonyms and, with a few exceptions, all subspecies listed in PNW-46 are excluded from the Northwest Check List. For practical reasons, common names have been assigned to the plant-species level of taxonomy.

In addition to the species listed in PNW-46, a total of 273 other species, which have been specifically identified in Oregon, are included in the Northwest Check List. These species were obtained by comparing PNW-46 with the following reports:

## Common Names

The Northwest Check List contains 4,120 common names representing 3,664 plant species (367 grasses; 196 grass-like; 2,579 forbs; and 522 shrubs and trees). Some species are known by more than one common name and these are cross-referenced in the Check List.

The primary authority for preferred common names is *Standardized Plant Names, 2nd Edition*, by Harlan P. Kelsey and William A. Dayton, with assistance from the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture, for the American Joint Committee on Horticultural Nomenclature. 1942.
