### **Guidelines for LFA Open Access Mandate**

#### OSU Libraries Copyright Agreement Addendum

LFA recommends that authors select the Access/Reuse agreement type using the Science Commons Scholar's Copyright Addendum Engine (<http://scholars.sciencecommons.org/>) and attach the resulting addendum to their article, following the instructions on that page. Under Access – Reuse, authors retain sufficient rights to post a copy of the published version of the article online immediately to ScholarsArchive@OSU. Authors also

“retain sufficient rights to grant to the reading public a Creative Commons Attribution Non Commercial license or similar license that allows the public to re-use or re-post your article so long as you are given credit as the author and so long as the reader's use is non-commercial. (This is a joint offering from Science Commons and SPARC and represents a new version of the former SPARC Addendum.)

#### Deposit

Authors should deposit the final version of the article themselves. If the author prefers, an electronic copy of the article should be sent as an email attachment to Linda Kathman ([linda.kathman@oregonstate.edu](mailto:linda.kathman@oregonstate.edu)). If it is not already evident, please include citation information. Linda will deposit the article and notify the author when it becomes available online in ScholarsArchive.

#### Waiver (Opt-Out)

A written request for a waiver to this policy should be submitted to the University Librarian's designate prior to the author signing a publisher agreement. The University Librarian's designate is the Library Faculty Association ScholarsArchive@OSU Coordinator. The Coordinator may assist the author in getting terms from the publisher that are most agreeable to the author.
