

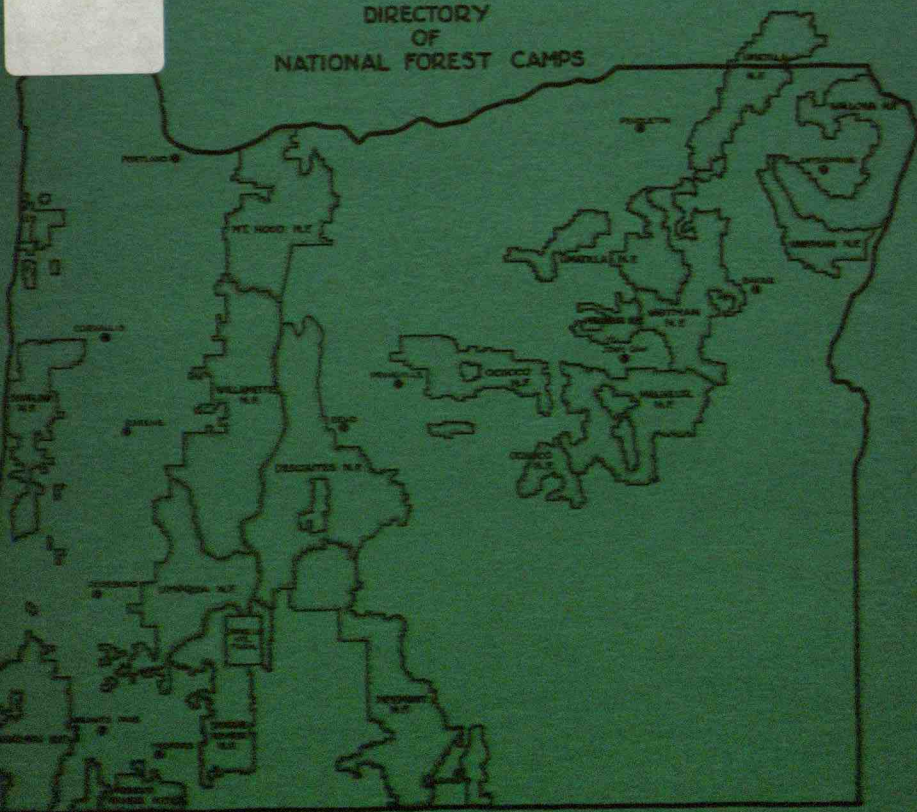

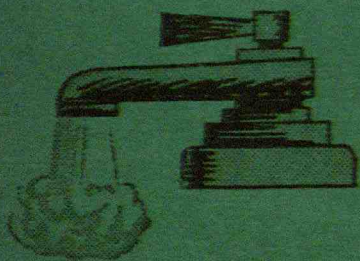

YOUR FORESTS

The National Forests are your forests. You own them and the United States Forest Service manages them for your benefit. The national Forests are held in trust for you and administered in accordance with the principle of "the greatest good for the largest number over the longest period of time."

National forests contribute much to the welfare and prosperity of our nation. From them we get water for domestic needs and power for homes and industries. They furnish lumber for buildings and thousands of other wood products for our use. Cattle and sheep graze on the forage within their boundaries--providing food, leather, and wool.

Each year millions hunt, fish, hike, camp, and use picnic areas on the forest. Recreation is not a tangible value like wood, grass, or water. You can't build houses with it, feed it to livestock, or use it to run factories. But, it is important to your well-being and happiness and that importance is recognized by your Forest Service.

For administrative purposes, the Forest Service has divided the United States into National Forest Regions. Oregon--which is in Region 6 (the Pacific Northwest region)--has 14.8 million acres of National Forest land. This is almost one quarter of the land area of the state.

Each National Forest is administered by a Forest Supervisor whose headquarters is shown on the cover map. National Forests are divided into districts, each managed by a District Ranger. During the busy summer season, Forest Guards assist the Ranger with his work.

CAMPFIRES

In Oregon, campfire permits are not required on the Rogue River, Siuslaw, Umatilla, and Whitman National Forests. However, you will not be allowed to build campfires in certain hazardous areas on these

forests. In this way, you will be helping the Forest Service protect your forests. These areas are posted. Campfire permits are required on all other National Forests except at campgrounds posted, "Campfire permits not required on this forest camp."

CAMPING & PICNICKING FEES

In recent years the Forest Service has not had enough money to keep your campgrounds in as good condition as they should be. Congress suggested that people who use National Forest camps should pay for their maintenance. Therefore, the Forest Service will have a few campgrounds maintained by special-use permittees who will collect nominal fees set by the Forest Service. These permittees will keep camps in good repair and free of refuse. All charge areas will be posted at entrances.

Charges for use of the few selected campgrounds during the 1951 season will be:

Camping: 50¢ per day, or \$3 per week, per car party of not more than six adults.

Picnicking: 25¢ per day per car party of not more than six adults.

Additional charges may be made for such services as split fire wood, lockers, or checking arrangements at bathhouses.

BACK-COUNTRY CAMPS

This directory does not include several less-accessible trail camps with rough accommodations provided by the Forest Service for fishermen, hunters, hikers, and other back-country travelers.

Information about wilderness areas, remote trips, camps, and other information about the forests can be obtained at supervisor headquarters or ranger stations.

IF LOST, REMAIN CALM
AND STAY WHERE YOU ARE.

Remember the figure 3. Three blasts on a whistle, three regulated puffs of smoke, three waves of a blanket, or three flashes of a mirror or flashlight repeated regularly will bring assistance.

The rescue party will answer with two signals.
Repeat your distress signal until you are found.

If you must use signal fires, be sure to clean away the duff and ground litter to mineral soil.

Before traveling through strange country, notify a Forest Officer of your approximate destination.
Let him know when you return.

The rule of three signals is used nation-wide and should never be used except when in actual need of help.

On Deschutes Riv Forest Rd 23 mi S of Bend, dirt rd. Supplies at Bend. Fishing, boating.

On Metolius Resorts Forest Rd 18 mi NW of Sisters, 40 mi NW of Bend. Supplies at Camp Sherman 3-1/2 mi. Fishing, hunting.

On east shore of East L, 1 mi from resort on unimproved rd, 19 mi off US-97. Fishing, boating.

McKenzie Hy, 4 mi W Sisters. Cap. 20 persons. 3 fire rings.

Your Forests

The National Forests are yours. Visit them, use the recreational facilities provided, enjoy your stay. But because they are your forests, you can help the Forest Service protect them from fire and vandalism. Practice the following suggestions--be a good camper.

Good Campers Will:

1. Build fires only in designated places and completely extinguish them with water before leaving. Apply water slowly and directly to the fire in a rock stove to avoid cracking the structure. If the stove has a door, the fire need not be completely extinguished.
2. Burn all refuse possible and place remainder in the garbage receptacle.
3. Share facilities when camps are crowded.
4. Keep signs, buildings, tables, and other conveniences in good condition--not deface them.
5. Not pick or dig flowers, plants, ferns, or moss in or near any forest camp. Not cut tent poles or boughs or chip tree bark.
6. Not wash clothing or clean fish in a lake or stream.
7. Not shoot firearms in the campground or vicinity.
8. Not shoot fireworks anywhere inside the National Forest.
