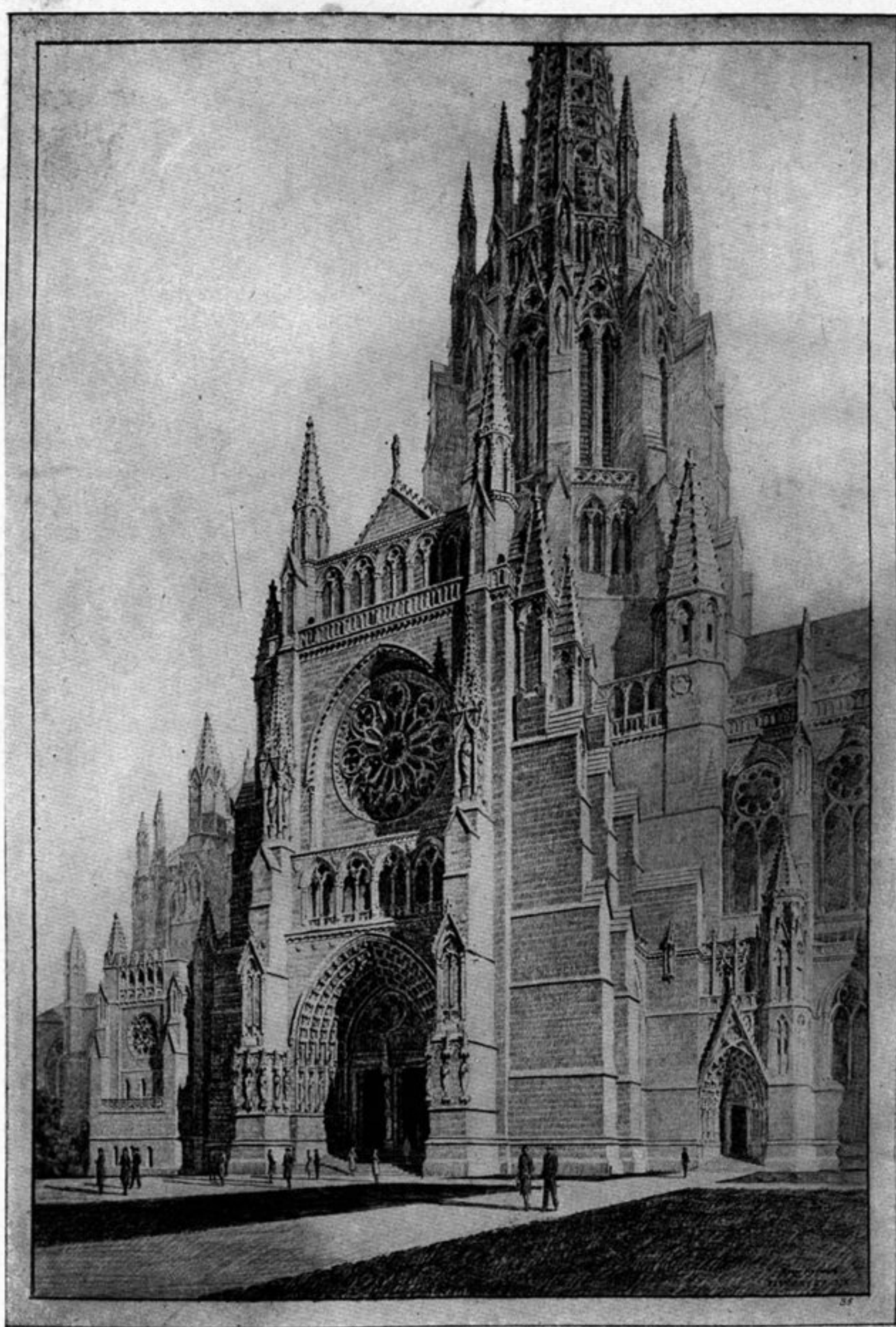

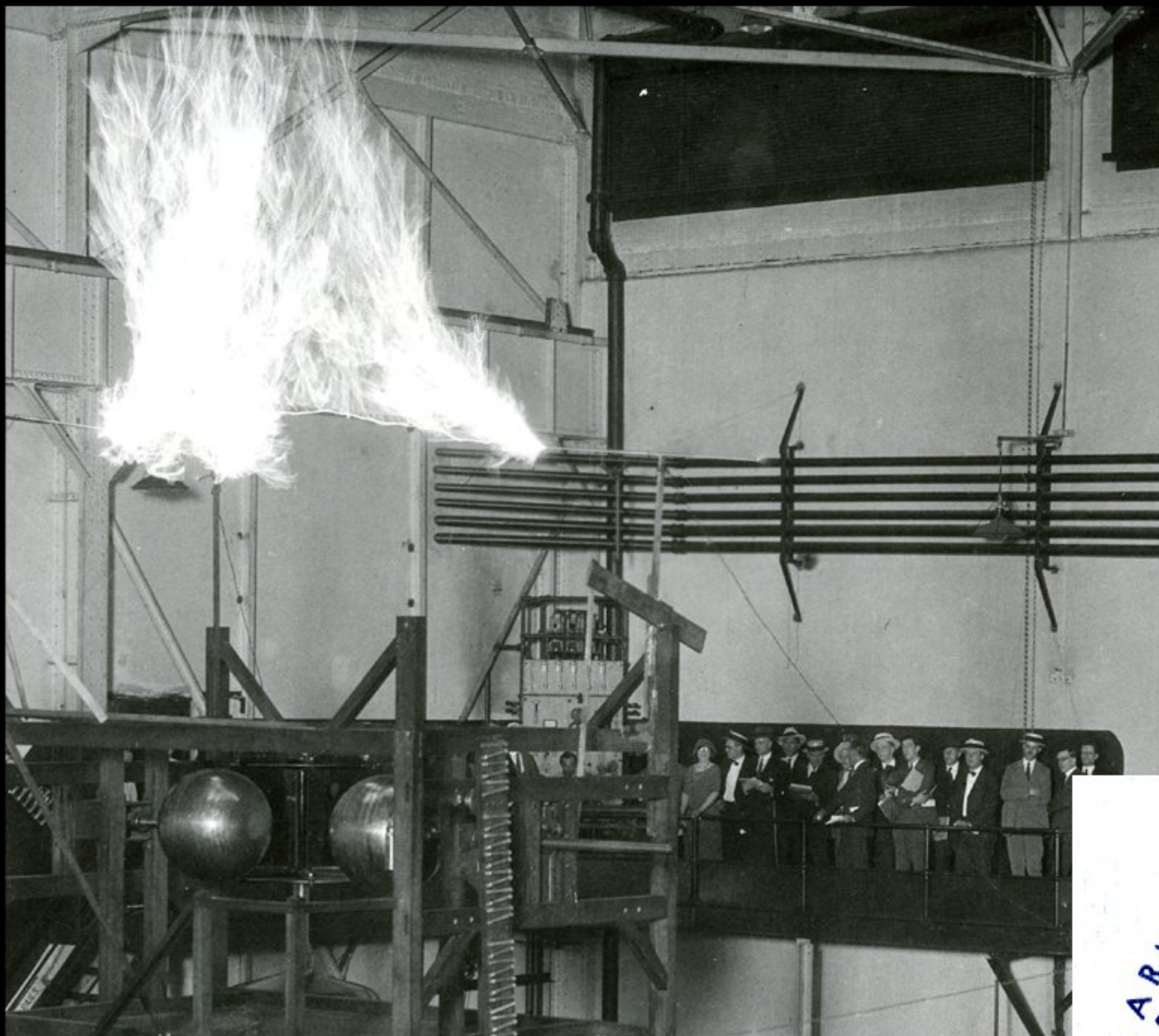




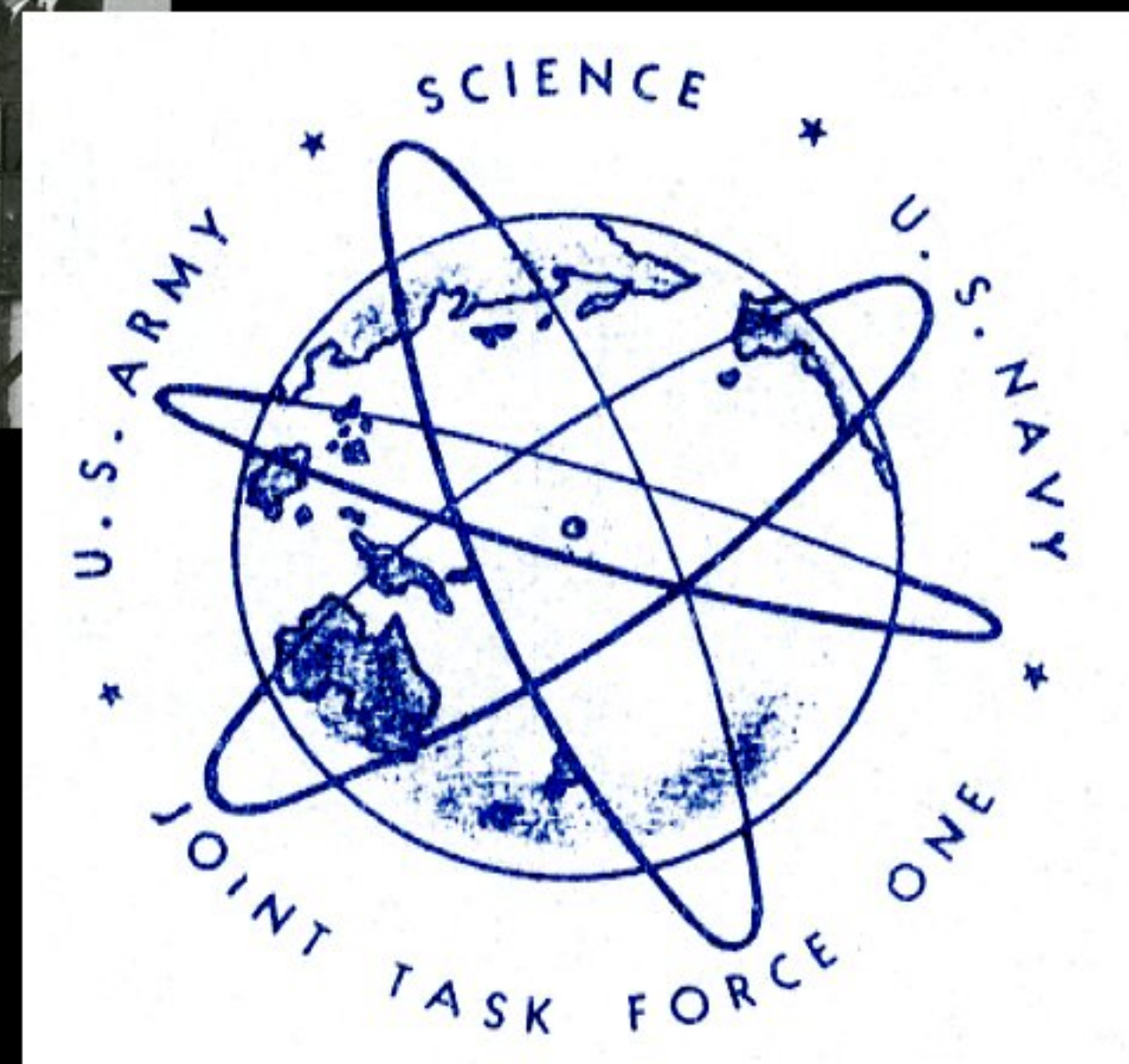


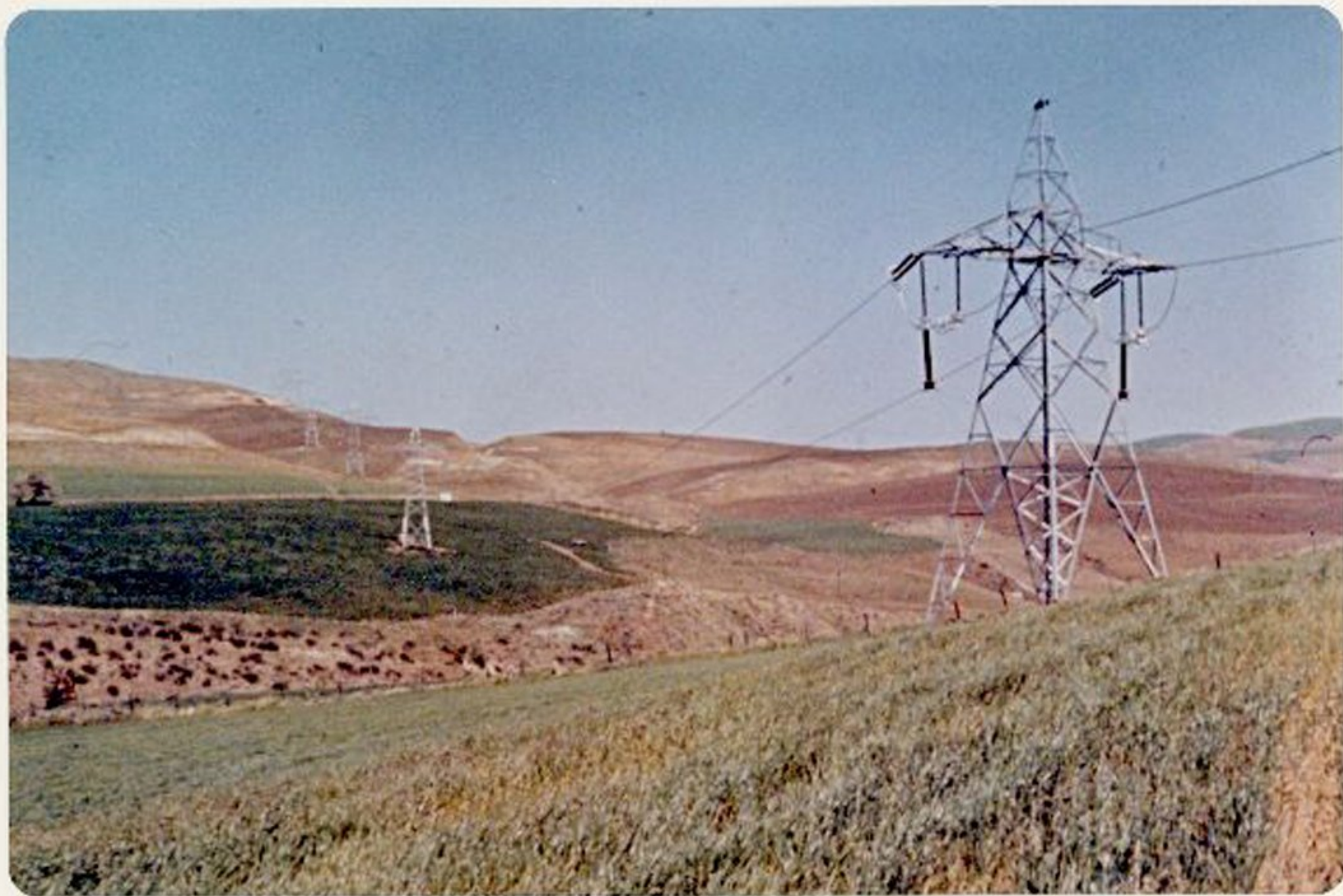




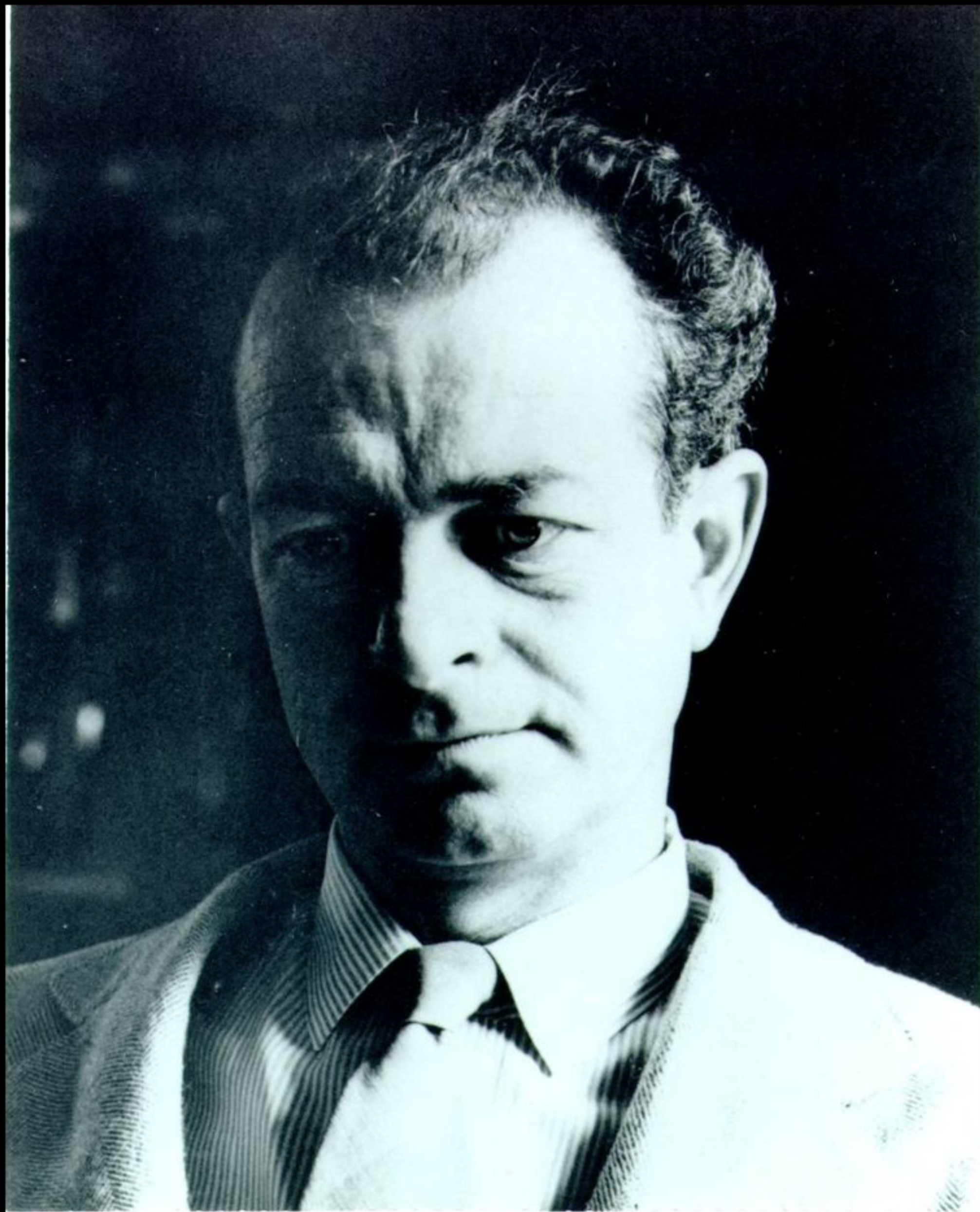


Newspaper writers observing 1 million volt,
