Demonstration: Card Swipe System

Chris White from UHDS Residential Computing Network demonstrated the card swipe system and talked about its implementation. The initial costs of the swipe machines are less than \$100 per swipe; however the cost of configuring the system, developing the interface and maintaining the database, etc. need in house support. Lisa Hoogesteger talked about its use in Rec Sports and some of the issues with customizing software and working with the ID center to pull the info that is needed. The card swipe acts like a keyboard so it enters the ID number which then can be linked to specific fields from Data Warehouse or other data sources.
