

## FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT AND DECISION RECORD

I have reviewed this environmental assessment, including the three alternatives and their environmental impacts, and have determined that burning for fuels reduction is in conformance with the Klamath Falls Resource Area RMP. Further, it is my determination that implementation of the Proposed Action (Alternative A) would not significantly impact the human environment and that an environmental impact statement is not required.

This determination of no significant impact is based on the analysis in this environmental assessment and EA#OR014-94-9, along with the project design features in this environmental assessment (including among others the use of Best Management Practices for soils and water and other resources, and notification of adjacent landowners). Another consideration for my determination is that the absence of prescribed fire in these areas could result in wild fires that alter the ecosystem in ways that result in undesirable cumulative effects.

Based on these determinations, it is my decision to implement Alternative A (Proposed Action), which proposes broadcast underburning with the option of handpile and burn in some areas, as provided in this environmental assessment.

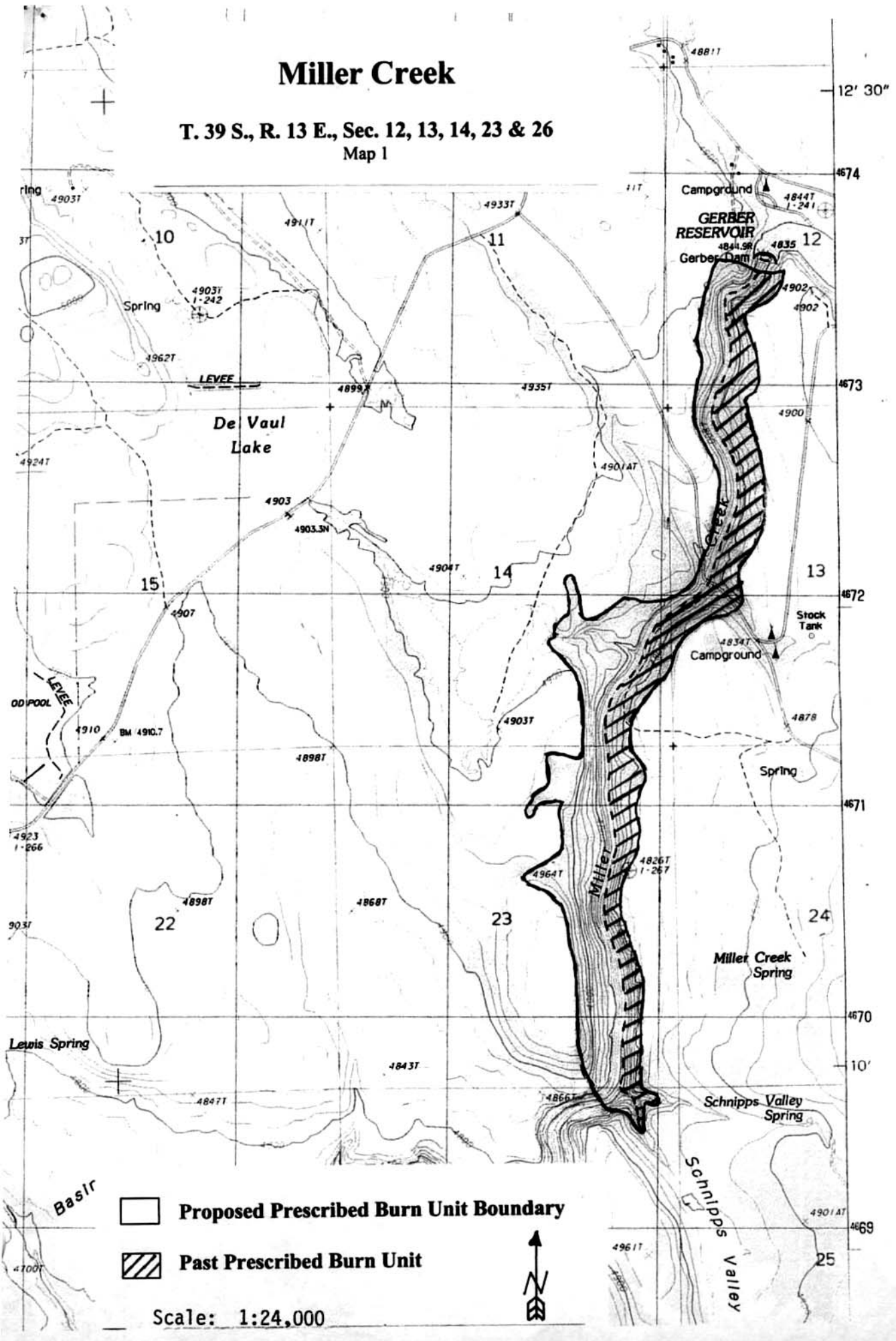

**Proposed Prescribed Burn Unit Boundary**



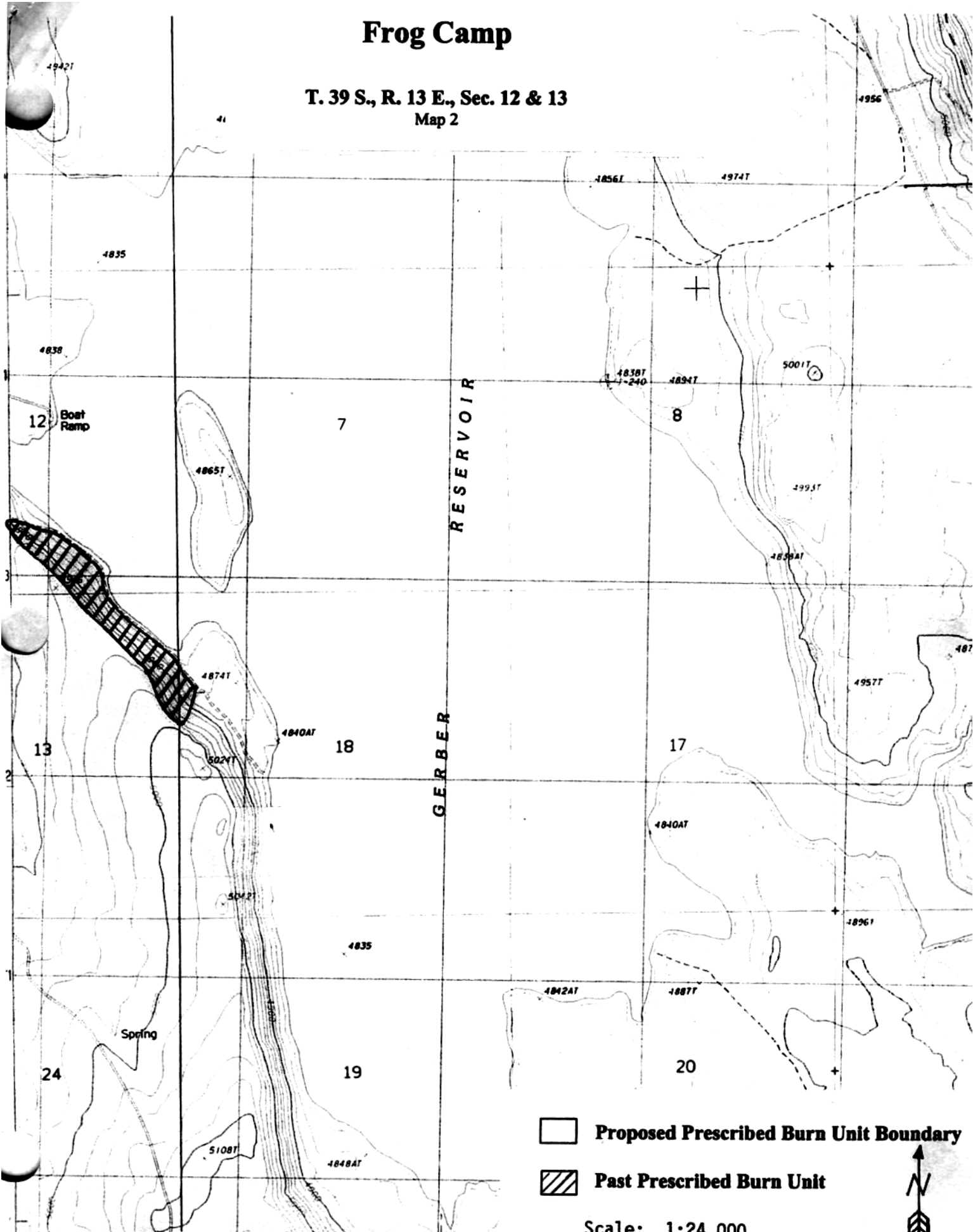
**Past Prescribed Burn Unit**


