

• 29 countries and the EU control 90% of the world's wild seafood



- Monthly expenditure claimed




Non-income






Housing type




Average household income/day (USD)



Frequency of fishing and selling catch in the last 6 months




Frequency of fish eaten in last six months







Percentage of cash income in household in last six months from fishing
