


EU TAC share under zonal attachment principle

Model: relative stability among remaining EU MS






The FishRent model






Brexit: Who will be affected?




UK fleet 70% of total landings 14%





Summary

- ➤ EU <u>and</u> UK fleets will suffer from Brexit (-2% up to -79% net profit reductions)
- Economic consequences depend on quota <u>and</u> fishing ground availability
- Brexit might increase choke problem
 - TAC distribution vial zonal attachment is not matching catch portfolio of fleets
- Indirect effect on fish stocks
