

7-ROOM FARMHOUSE

This compact well-arranged onestory house has three bedrooms which are closed off from the living space. The rear entry is large enough to serve as a laundry and washroom and constitutes a back way from the kitchen to the bedrooms without passing through the living room. A door from the living room to the bedroom hall could be provided if desired. The kitchen, with cross ventilation and ample cupboard and counter space, is a pleasant place to work. A basement permits the installation of a central heating plant. For mild or cold localities.
