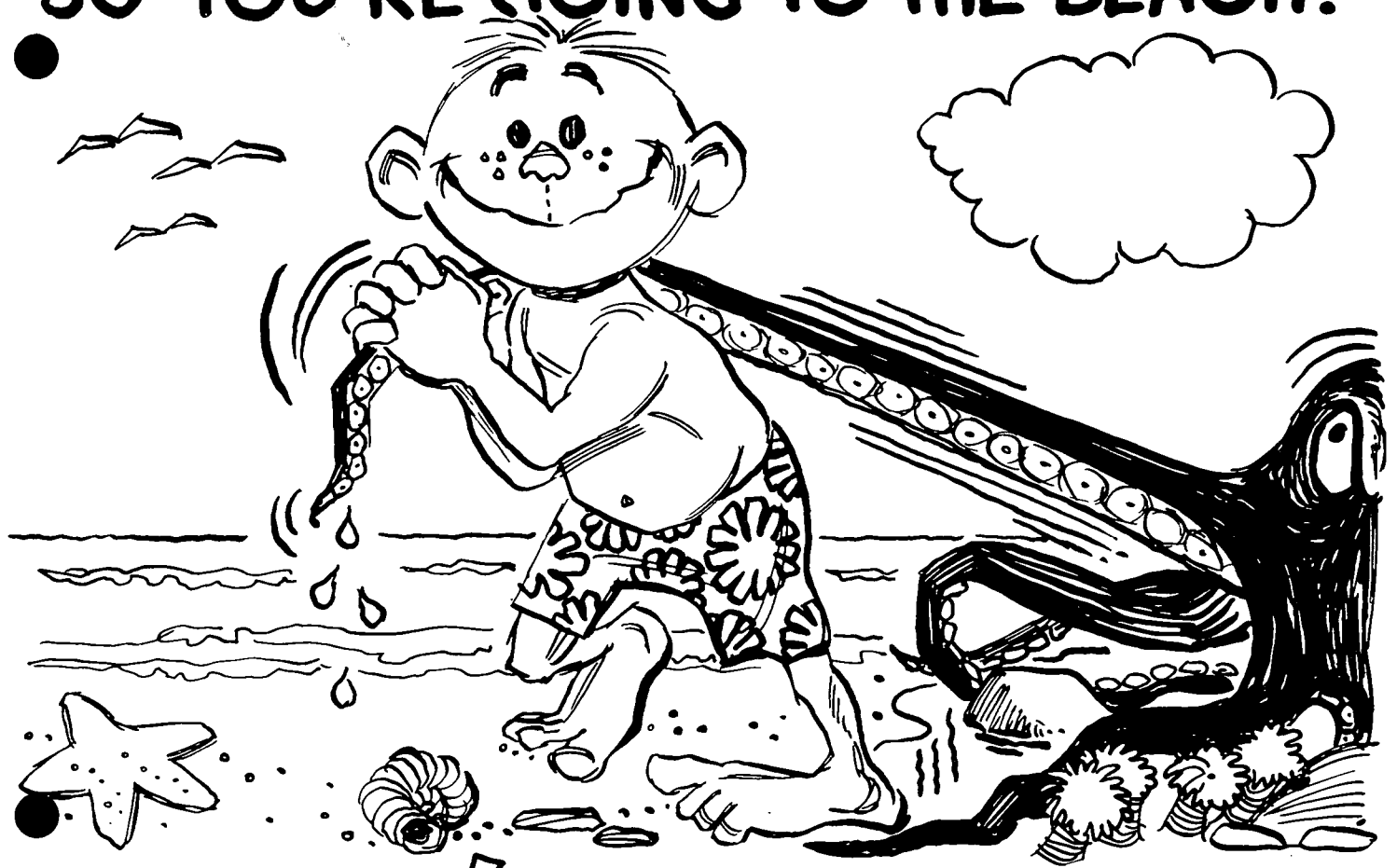

OREGON LAW EXTENDS PROTECTION TO ALL INTERTIDAL ANIMAL FORMS INCLUDING STARFISH, SEA URCHINS, SEA CUCUMBERS, SHORE, HERMIT AND OTHER SMALL CRABS, SNAILS, BIVALVES, SEA ANEMONES, AND ALL OTHER NON FOOD ANIMALS. **PERMIT ONLY AREAS:** NO INTERTIDAL ANIMALS MAY BE TAKEN FROM THE FOLLOWING AREAS EXCEPT BY SPECIAL PERMIT ISSUED BY THE OREGON FISH COMMISSION: BOILER BAY, DEPOE BAY, YAQUINA HEAD, AND NEPTUNE, SUNSET, CAPE ARAGO, AND HARRIS BEACH STATE PARKS. IT IS UNLAWFUL TO WANTONLY WASTE OR DESTROY ANY INTERTIDAL ANIMAL FORM AT ANY TIME.
