When a PDF map is opened in Adobe Acrobat, the Basemap Elements layers will be visible by default (turned on) and the Biophysical Thematic Elements layers will be invisible (turned off). To change which layers are visible, locate the **layers icon** at the left of the screen, like the one shown here at left. Layers can also be accessed from: View ▶ Show/Hide ▶ Navigation Panes ▶ Layers.
