The original concept was that of a checklist of all the macrophytic marine algae. By the term macrophytic is intended individual plants large enough to be distinguished by the unaided eye in the field. This distinction becomes difficult to maintain when one considers "colonial" types such as Collinsiella, unicellular forms such as Codiolum or Chlorochytrium forms or even multicellular but essentially hidden endophytes as Endophyton, Myrionema or Compsonema.

Certain arbitrary decisions have been made. Unicellular motile forms, such as Dunaliella, Tetraselmis and all of the Diatoms have been omitted. The Cyanophyta (blue-green algae) have been omitted simply because so little information is available. Hopefully, in the near future it will be possible to compile an addendum containing all or some major part of the omitted information.

An effort has been made to construct this list to provide the maximum amount of information in the briefest possible format. The names of the entities are listed alphabetically under each genus and the genera are arranged in alphabetic order. The great majority of the entities named have had their occurrence recorded repeatedly. In a few cases a brief note indicates that a species has not been reported since an early record. The names of entities whose discontinuous distribution in California and Washington indicates the great probability of their eventual discovery in Oregon are preceded by an asterisk. Names used in commonly available manuals and floristic lists, that have been reduced to synonymy, are listed enclosed in parentheses and followed by the legitimate epithet.

As the list presently stands, it contains the names of 72 entities in the Chlorophycophyta, 82 entities in the Phaeophycophyta and 213 in the Rhodophycophyta for a total of 367 entities.
