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I. Background

The Counseling Academic Unit (CAU) of the College of Education (CoE) at Oregon State University (OSU) has provided counselor training since 1916 (Oregon Agricultural College, 1916). This date was only five years after Harvard University offered the first counseling course in the nation (Savickas, 2009). OSU is tied with Columbia University for operating the 2nd oldest continuous counseling program in the nation (Savickas, 2009).

The CAU awarded its first master's degree in 1929 (Love, 1929). In 1937, the Oregon University System (OUS) granted OSU the right to award a doctorate in counseling (Oregon State College, 1937). However, the Great Depression and World War II intervened and the first counseling doctorate at OSU was not awarded until 1947 (Wentworth-Rohr, 1947). Since 1947, the CAU has produced nearly 200 doctoral dissertations.

The CAU has offered graduate-level coursework in counseling through an off-campus program since 1937 (Oregon State System of Higher Education, 1936). The initial off-campus course was provided via OUS' Portland Extension Center and taught at Lincoln High School on Tuesday evenings. The first OSU counseling master's degree student to graduate through the Portland Extension Center occurred in 1941. The CAU transitioned the counseling doctorate to an off-campus modality in 2001. At present, the CAU offers a 150-quarter credit hour PhD with a major in counseling using a hybrid instructional model. The CAU's hybrid model includes a mixture of (a) in-person instruction that occurs two weekends of

the quarter at an off-campus site, (b) synchronous web instruction via Adobe Connect, and (c) asynchronous web instruction via Blackboard. This degree program enrolls students who reside throughout the United States. As such, the CAU and OSU Libraries felt it important to give these students, as well as other scholars, access to this large corpus of counseling dissertations. Thus, this bibliographic database was created and all counseling dissertations were digitized for full-text online access.

II. Scope of Database

This bibliographic database contains all doctoral dissertations completed by students within OSU's Counseling Academic Unit. This includes all dissertations for the EdD degree (1947-1986) and the PhD degree (1969-present).

Titles for the doctoral major in counseling have been (a) Education, (b) Guidance and Counseling, and (c) Counseling. Until 1995, there was some overlap of these titles. Since 1995 counseling has been the sole title for the major. Counseling doctoral students who had a major of Education also had a Counseling area of concentration that was variously titled: *Vocational Guidance*, *Guidance*, *Guidance & Counseling*, or *Counseling*. In most, but not all cases, this area of concentration did not appear on the dissertation signature page.

III. Database Construction

Constructing a database with a 66-year time span always requires editorial activity. To start, I consulted the dissertation bibliographic indices put out by the OSU Libraries. These indices were for 1932-1942 (Oregon State System Of Higher Education, 1946), 1943-1959 (Waldron & Followell, 1960), 1960-1965 (Brandt, 1967), 1966-1970 (Guss, 1973), 1970-1977 (Brown, 1980), 1978-1982 (Leasher, 1982), and 1983-1992 (Glenn, 1994). These indices were constructed by topic rather than by academic unit. Thus, once the list of potential counseling dissertations was compiled, some editorial decisions had to be made. Some dissertations listed had a counseling component but the main focus was on another topic (see Woodward, 1954). In these cases the academic appointment of the major professor was a big help in determining if the dissertation had emerged from the CAU.

1980s-present. Determining CAU dissertations from 1980 onwards was relatively straightforward. CoE and OSU alumni records are complete for students with a counseling major code. However, some PhD and EdD dissertations still had Education listed as a major. In both CoE and alumni records, counseling area of concentration codes do not exist for CAU students who had a major in Education. In these cases, the bibliographies from the era as well the academic appointment of the major professor determined inclusion in the database.

1970s. Dissertations from the 1970s were determined by a combination of bibliographic records and the academic appointment of the major professor.

Retired CAU faculty members from that period were also consulted.

1937-1969. Early dissertations were determined by a combination of bibliographic records and the academic appointment of the major professor.

Dissertations with a Student Affairs Focus.

Special editorial decisions had to be made with dissertations with a student affairs focus (*n.b.*, also known as *student personnel services* or *college student services administration*). In most universities, student affairs graduate programs are housed in a counseling academic unit (i.e., the **Related Educational Programs** in **CACREP**). OSU is an exception. Except for college counseling, all of student affairs graduate preparation at OSU was separated from the CAU in 1966 (Oregon State University College of Education, 2013). Thus, all non-counseling student affairs dissertations of doctoral candidates that enrolled after 1966 were excluded from this bibliography. Student affairs dissertations prior to 1966 were included in this database unless the topic did not directly focus on counseling or student personnel work (i.e., Casebeer, 1963; Van Loan, 1959).
