## Categorical Exclusion No. KCER-01-28 Name Stukel Mowing

**Description of Proposed Action**: The mowing of small trees, brush and natural fuels on 80 acres on the Klamath Resource Area.

Location of Proposed Action: Stukel Mountain

*Categorical Exclusion Review*: The Stukel Mountain mowing project, has been reviewed and qualifies as a categorical exclusion based on 516 DM <u>6</u> Appendix 5.4 <u>C(4)</u>, which provides for the precommercial thinning and brush control using small mechanical devices.

The proposal has also been screened to determine if any special circumstances exist that would warrant NEPA analysis and documentation. This project does not meet the criteria for exception under 516 DM 2, Appendix 2 as summarized below:

1. Health and Safety; 2. Unique Resources; 3. Controversial; 4. Risks; 5. Precedent; 6. Cumulative; 7. Cultural and Historical; 8. Threatened or Endangered Species; 9. Flood plains, Wetlands or Fish & Wildlife Coordination Act, 10. Violate Law.


