### Working for profit:

5. Cull unprofitable cows.
6. Feed grain according to production.
7. Well grown heifers are more profitable.
8. Use a good purebred bull.

## Owner-Sampler Herd Book

The owner-sampler herd book is not an official D.H.I.A. record. The milk and butterfat records are calculated by the D.H.I.A. tester from butterfat tests made from samples taken by the dairyman.

### Herd Owner

1. The records obtained by this testing method will be of value to you only if they are accurate and complete. Herd operation such as feeding and culling should be based on the knowledge obtained from this record book.

2. On test day weigh and sample the milk accurately at each milking.

3. Report feed weights and prices accurately.

4. Remember that one good producing cow may make you more profit than two low producing cows.
