

CHECKLIST FOR A BASIC FORESTRY LIBRARY

Introduction

A "Check List of Items in a Working Library" was compiled in 1950 at the suggestion of the Council of Forestry School Executives. This list was revised and brought up to date, published in the JOURNAL OF FORESTRY, Vol. 56, No. 8, August 1958, and reprinted. The revision was done by Mary Lida Eakin, Librarian, Forestry Library, in consultation with the staff, School of Forestry, University of California.

In 1961 a "Supplement to the Society of American Foresters Check List of Forestry Items in a Working Library" was compiled by Esther M. Johnson, Librarian, Forestry Library, in consultation with the staff, School of Forestry, University of California. The Supplement was published in the JOURNAL OF FORESTRY, Vol. 60, No. 2, February 1962 and reprinted.

Recently, the need for a further revision of the Checklist, which is used by SAF and forestry schools for accreditation purposes, has become apparent. The present list has been compiled for the Society of American Foresters by Lora Kelts, Agriculture-Forestry Librarian, Oregon State University Library, and Bernice F. Smith, Forestry Librarian, College of Forest Resources Library, University of Washington, in consultation with the staff, School of Forestry, Oregon State University. Materials used were the Checklist and lists submitted by the following: Terence J. Hoverter, Librarian, F. Franklin Moon Memorial Library, State University College of Forestry at Syracuse University; Bernice F. Smith, Forestry Librarian, College of Forest Resources Library, University of Washington; and International Forestry Staff, U. S. Forest Service, Washington, D. C.

This publication, in addition to its use for accreditation purposes, is designed to be a guideline and convenient reference in the development and maintenance of institutional libraries on forestry. A rating is given each item to reflect the suggested desirability of its inclusion, number one designating items considered most desirable. The following headings, which follow the Oxford System of Decimal Classification for Forestry, are used:
