

Corvallis December 30th 1875

We the Undersigned Trustees of Corvallis College duly elected by the Methodist Episcopal Church South according to its usages and regulations at the annual Session at Albany in September 1875 do make and subscribe the following supplementary articles of Incorporations in addition to those filed October 2^d 1868 to wit: Add to to Article 2^d and with full power and authority to make execute and deliver checks, promissory notes or Bills of Exchange for the purpose of paying the debts of said institution and purchase property necessary for the same, and to make execute and deliver deeds and mortgages to all or any of the property of said Institution when the same shall be sold as mortgaged, and to sell any and all property belonging to said College when the same may be deemed unsuitable. and to purchase and hold other property of any name or nature necessary and suitable to the complete success and purposes of said institution. not exceeding to sum of five hundred thousand dollars.

2^d add to article 3^d the following, to wit:
The present estimated value of the property of said institution at Corvallis is \$13,000. thirteen thousand dollars, and its sources of revenue appropriations of the Legislature of Oregon, and the proceeds of lands donated by the Congress of the United States, and interest on the money arising from said sales and rents of the property of said College.
